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






how resources, often finances, are shared between different groups or for different purposes.

 The role of the third sector in providing support











The third sector is a range of different organisations with different structures and purposes, belonging neither to the public sector (the state) nor to the private sector (profitmaking private enterprise).

- Moving away from eligibility thresholds and reducing how much is spent on wasted administration.
- Autonomy of support workers and co-production of solutions with carers



Autonomy means able to make good decisions without having to ask a manager every time.
